GENERAL ACHIEVEMENTS IN VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS

AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES

The garden and Nursery; it has been upgraded and many new seedlings added e.g. lemons, oranges etc. many others are due to be introduced within a short while as we look forward to its expansion. This however, has not been easy and efficient due to challenges of water shortages and prevailing weather conditions.

The cow project- it is quite encouraging as the results are worth and positive. Recently one cow has given birth to a calf which is healthy and growing. The project acts as a source of milk to the children hence it is of great nutritional value.

The chicken project- has been of great advantage and importance as it is a source of eggs hence source of protein for the children. We are planning to expand this to ensure self- sustainability.

Our tomatoes in the green house have been very successful and yielding. We are yearning that it will not only sustain the children in food security but also a research centre in future.

All these projects have basically had advantage to the children as source of food and when expanded, they could generate income for the school.

EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

Primary school; - successful opening for third term took place with significant increase of pupil's population. However, it is experiencing challenges in terms of staff and teachers. This year, we are presenting 20 candidates for the National examinations, **KCPE** and we expect them to do exemplary well.

Secondary School: - Schooling for all students commenced without any problems with all students and available teachers aiming to improve the good results of the

previous term which were as a result of hard work. We have made enormous improvements in discipline, uniforms and examinations. We are happy to present 3 pioneer candidates for the national exams, **KCSE** whom we expect to perform very well as they have always done in school exams.

This section however encounters challenges from various grounds including inadequate teachers, insufficient teaching materials and facilities like classrooms,

books & laboratory. When improved and facilities acquired, CGHS will be a centre of academic excellence, not only in Nairobi but also the entire country.

ENVIRONMENT

All children participate in day to day activities and responsibilities hence creating a sense of hard work and co-operation bringing into their minds information, interdependence and self- sustainability.

Their activities to emphasize care on environment include, cleaning dormitories, dinning hall, kitchen and general compound. We mould them in tilling flowers and flower beds as well as in laundry like washing clothes.

HEALTH LIFESTYLES AND MEDICAL CARE

Due to availability of water in the home, the children have maintained high standards of cleanliness. The efficient flow of water this month has facilitated effective running of hygienic activities like washing clothes, cooking, cleaning dorms etc.

Resultantly, health levels in the home have increased significantly. However babies require a special diet with plenty of proteins and calcium for growth hence this requires much attention and concentration, for proper care and support.
